


Annually, over 300 million tons of plastic is produced around the world and unfortunately, more than 90% of that plastic is not recycled. Distressingly enough, much of that plastic ends up in our oceans with at least 8 million tons of plastic being dumped into the ocean each year. While plastic has become pervasive in our environment and homes, there are changes each of us can make to improve the situation, and that is what Mind Your Plastic is here to do.

OUR IMPACT


2021 Annual Report Statistics:

Did you know that a city the size of Montreal can produce up to 45,000 tonnes of waste annually just from events held on municipal property?

Smaller municipalities produce an average of 20,000 tonnes of waste. What's the solution?

We are working with Canadian municipalities to enact a Plastic-Free Events Policy that would hold event hosts accountable for plastic-waste and prohibit the excessive use of single-use items.

PLASTIC REDUCTION TOOLKITS FOR BUSINESSES

CIRCULAR **ECONOMY** AMBASSADOR PROGRAM (CEAP)

YOUTH ARE THE FUTURE OF CANADA!

In 2021, we launched the Circular Economy Ambassador Program (CEAP).

CEAP is a voluntary teacher-led program that engages youth in community cleanups with a goal of:

- Cleaning up trash
- Sorting and tracking their findings
- Identifying where it came from
- Diverting as much as possible from landfill

Teachers are provided with a curriculum to support teaching the youth about the harmful effects of plastic on our environment and the importance of transitioning to a circular economy. Mind Your Plastic also provides resources for diverting waste specific to the school's municipality, as well as reusable cleanup materials.

In 2022, we have a goal of engaging 3,000 students across all Canadian provinces and territories. With your support, we can continue to expand access to environmental education and inspire our future leaders!
